





# STANDARD SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS Tokoroa Airfield ¼ Mile Single Car Standing Sprint & Autocross Tokoroa Airfield, Moffatt Road (off SH1), Tokoroa Sunday 11 August 2024

# 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Basic Event promoted by MotorSport Bay of Plenty Inc at Tokoroa Airfield, Moffatt Road, Tokoroa.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Schedule C, Part One, Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Schedule C, Part Two, Appendix Five, pertaining to Motorkhana's and Schedule A, Appendix Two – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

### 3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

- **3.1** Tarmac Surface Quarter Mile Single Car Standing Sprint and Tarmac Surface Autocross.
- **3.4 Results:** Fastest run wins, by class and overall. NOTE: The timing equipment used records both reaction time and jumped starts. In the case of a jumped start a penalty of 5 seconds will be applied to that run. The Start Line Crew will also be judges of fact regarding jumped starts.
- 3.3 Venue: Tokoroa Airfield, Moffatt Road, off SH1, Tokoroa

**Damage to the Venue:** Please note that the Tarmac Runway is boarded by 2 x Grass Runways. If a vehicle leaves the Tarmac Runway and causes damage to the extent that the venue owners charge Motorsport Bay of Plenty for the repairs, then this cost will be passed onto the driver of the car that caused the damage.

- 3.4 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes.
  - A 0-1600cc
  - B 1601-2000
  - C 2001-3500cc
  - D 3501 and over
  - E1 4WD pre year 2000
  - E2 4WD year 2000 and over
  - XC Cross Cars

The Club prefers that entries are made online; however, entries will be accepted on the day up to the close of Documentation at 10am.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at the end of Documentation at 10:00am for both events. **Entries will be accepted on the day.**

#### 4.4 ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

**Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

Tyres: Free. Run any type of tyre you want to.

All vehicles shall as a minimum be to a warrantable standard, with a securely mounted seat, safe steering and effective brakes.

The Clerk of the Course has discretionary powers as to the type of vehicle deemed suitable for the venue.

#### 5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

#### 5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold a current club membership of a member club except for new entrants to motorsport, who may compete in two (2) Basic Status Events before being required to join a club.

The licence requirements are as follows:

(1) Basic Status Events: A competition licence is not required.

(a) Junior Competitors: Any competitor between the ages 12-16 years who does not hold a valid MotorSport NZ competition licence may be allowed to compete in Basic Status Events on the following conditions;

(i) That the venue restrictions along with the vehicle type and cubic capacity restrictions detailed in Appendix One Schedule L Part One Article 3.2(2) are respected, and

(ii) Only at the discretion of the Event Clerk of the Course.

## 5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- 5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

These are Clubsport Basic Events. Clothing requirements are as follows:

- Helmet
- Overalls Minimum of Cotton Overalls
- No Fireproof Underwear or socks required
- Minimum of leather shoes
- No gloves required
